Good morning. My name is, Mary Beth Lavey, Chairperson of the Occupational Therapy Section of the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board. Let the record show that this proceeding was called to order at 10:00 AM on July 15, 2021, at the Vern Riffe Center, 77 S. High St., Columbus, OH 43215.

Members of the Board present for the proceeding are:

It will be noted for the record that a majority of the members of the Board are present.

There will be one adjudication proceeding today. The proceeding is in the matter of **Andrea Stadelman, case # 21-083**.

These proceedings shall be affidavit-based adjudications relative to the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed to the respondent in the aforementioned case and believed to have been properly served according to the Administrative Procedures Act (Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code).

As the respondents declined to have a hearing in the case, this proceeding will be held before the Board pursuant to *Goldman v. State Medical Board of Ohio*. The individuals named do not have the ability to present written or oral testimony today but may be present to hear the proceeding and outcome.

You have already received a sworn affidavit from the Board's Enforcement Division Investigator, and the accompanying exhibits for the Goldman Proceedings in your Board packet. The affidavit contains the evidence and testimony upon which you will deliberate. Please take a few moments to review the evidence and testimony.

In lieu of a stenographic record being made, let the minutes reflect that the original sworn affidavit and exhibits shall be kept as the official record of the proceeding in the aforementioned matter in the Board office.

I will now recognize Assistant Attorney General Lindsay Miller for the purpose of providing a brief synopsis of the case. Ms. Miller requested that Enforcement Investigator Jaklyn Shucofsky present a synopsis of the case.

Having heard Ms. Shucofsky's synopsis of the case, may I now have a motion to admit the facts and exhibits outlined in the sworn affidavit in the aforementioned case placed into the record as evidence. Beth Ann Ball made a motion, seconded by Melissa Van Allen. Motion passed. Anissa Siefert abstained.

There being no further evidence to come before the Board, this proceeding is now closed at 10:34 AM. The procedural and jurisdictional matters having been satisfied, we will now continue with the proceedings by deliberation on the sworn affidavits and exhibits. At this time, is there a motion to recess the meeting in order to go into private session for the purpose of quasi-judicial deliberation on **Andrea Stadelman, case # 21-083** and to reconvene the meeting after deliberations are complete. Joanne Estes made a motion, seconded by Beth Ann Ball.

The section came out of private session and reconvened the Board meeting at 10:42 AM.

The chair, Mary Beth Lavey asked for a motion on the findings of fact. Melissa Van Allen made a motion, second by Joanne Estes to accept the following Findings of Fact. Motion passed. Anissa Siefert abstained.

- **Andrea Stadelman** is a licensed OT.
- **Andrea Stadelman** received the request for the CE audit.
- During the CE audit of OTAs for the 7/1/2017- 6/30/2019 license renewal period, **Andrea Stadelman** failed to provide evidence of the CE completion.
- **Andrea Stadelman** failed to respond to the multiple notices for opportunity of hearing.
- The board has jurisdiction based on chapter 4755 of the ORC.

The Board makes the following Conclusion of Law:

- The licensee failed to comply with 4755-9-01.

After review of the evidence and testimony, Melissa Van Allen made the motion, second by Joanne Estes to accept the conclusion of Law. Motion passed Anissa Siefert abstained.

- The board recommends revoking the license of **Andrea Stadelman, OTA.**

Melissa Van Allen made a motion to accept the order of the Board for **Andrea Stadelman, case # OT-21-083.** Second by Joanne Estes. Motion passed. Anissa Siefert abstained.

The Executive Director is hereby instructed to prepare an adjudication order to carry out the mandate of this Board and serve the orders on **Andrea Stadelman, case # OT-21-083** in the manner prescribed by law.






