Code of Ethics

Brian Weaver made a motion that draft rule 4755-64-01, ethical and professional conduct be filed with JCARR. Seconded by Tammy Daulton. All in favor. Motion passed.

House Bill 263 rules

Brian Weaver moved that the Executive Director submit rule 4755-62-01 Definition of Terms, 4755-63-06 Applications for initial licensure by examination, and 4755-63-06 Temporary license application procedure for early stakeholder release. Seconded by Derek Kinsella. All in favor. Motion passed.

First time renewal CE exemption

Brian Weaver moved that the Executive Director submit draft rule 4755-65-01 Continuing education requirements and reporting for early stakeholder release. Seconded by Derek Kinsella. All in favor. Motion passed.

Legislative Licensure Reform

The Committee discussed recommendations from the House State and Local Government Committee to eliminate temporary licenses for OPP and to require licensure to be based on certification requirements. The committee discussed and gave the following feedback:

- Eliminating temporary licenses should not be a problem.
- Basing licensure on certification would actually create a barrier to licensure. Certification requires an additional hands-on examination that is only offered a couple of times a year.
