Melissa L. Wilburn, AAG, informed the Section that HB290 will go into effect on August 6<sup>th</sup> which will allow healthcare professionals earn continuing education credit for volunteer work. The board will need to adopt rules for this provision. Ms. Wilburn further reported that there is proposed language in HB49 which would track licensees arrest records between renewals. The proposed language will not change our licensure laws. The Board can only take disciplinary action on convictions not arrest records.

Enforcement Report

Jean Halpin reported that the Enforcement Division opened twelve cases and closed eight cases since the March 9, 2017, meeting. There are currently twelve cases open. There is one consent agreement and two adjudication orders being monitored.


Next Meeting Date
