Call to Order

Mary Beth Lavey, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:01 AM.

Executive Director's Report

Director Anthony announced that the OT Section has five members on the board. One member's term has expired, and has applied for reappointment. To date the Governor's office has not appointed anyone to fill that spot. We are currently operating as a four member board.

- Budget- revenue slight decline because of extension of expiration dates due to COVID-19. Email, postcard, newsletter and social media reminders are being sent and posted.
- Several tickets are pending in eLicense.
- Expenses are as expected, with a substantial increase in rent being anticipated.

- Enforcement Investigator position has been approved for posting.
- Several bills in the Senate including license reciprocity, Fresh Start, and telehealth bill which needs language cleaned up.
- Licensure reciprocity,
- Budget- increase in rent- Riffe working on renewed space planning efforts
- Riffe does maintain 24 hour security.
- Still working remotely. Jabber has allowed staff to answer calls and provide prompt customer service.


