Call to Order

Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendation

The Board will now consider the matter of Weslee Patton (case# PT-21-022), for whom a hearing was held before Hearing Officer Karl W. Schedler on May 04, 2022.

In accordance with Board procedures, the members who reviewed the case information for this individual and made a recommendation to the Board regarding the case information, shall not participate in further adjudication of the case and must abstain from further participation in the adjudication of these matters.

Tony Ganim and CJ Miller left the room.

Hearing Officer Schedler served a Report and Recommendation to the Board office on June 28, 2022. Mr. Patton received a copy of the Report and Recommendation via certified mail on July 7, 2022. Mr. Patton did not file written objections to the Report and Recommendation and declined to orally address the Board on July 11, 2022.

Chairman, Tim McIntire reminded the Board that Pursuant to Section 4755.47(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, you may dismiss the charges against Mr. Weslee Patton if you find they are not supported by reliable, probative and substantial evidence, or if you find the charges are supported by the evidence, you may impose the following on Mr. Patton's physical therapist assistant license:

- Limit
- Suspend
- Revoke
- Reprimand
- Fine
- Place on probation
- Require corrective action courses

Karen McIntyre moved to accept the hearing officer's findings of fact. Mario Baker seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried.

Karen McIntyre moved to reject the hearing officer's conclusions of law as written. Mario Baker seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried.

Karen McIntyre moved to accept the hearing officer's conclusions of law numbers 1-5 Mario Baker seconded the

motion. All in favor. The motion carried.

Karen McIntyre moved to reject the hearing officer's recommendation as written. Mario Baker seconded the motion. All in favor. The motion carried.

Karen McIntyre moved to modify the hearing officer's recommendation to impose a reprimand, a minimum of 6 cumulative hours of coursework in ethical boundary issues as approved by the board within 6 months of the date of this order, employer notification during the term of the order, and no fine. A reprimand, related coursework, and employer notification is consistent with customary discipline of this nature by the OTPTAT Board. Mario Baker seconded. All in favor. Motion carried

Karen McIntyre moved that, pursuant to section 4755.031 of the Ohio Revised Code, fees be assessed against Mr. Weslee Patton. CJ Miller and Tony Ganim abstained. All in favor. The motion carried.

Melissa Anthony reported that the costs required under section 4755.031 of the Ohio Revised Code covered a total of two invoices: (1) hearing officer (\$1,845.00) and (2) court reporter with a transcript (\$708.75). The total cost for the two vendors is \$2,553.75.

The Executive Director is hereby instructed to prepare an adjudication order to carry out the mandate of this Board and serve the order on Mr. Weslee Patton in the manner prescribed by law.

This concludes the matter of Weslee Patton, case # PT-21-022.

Licensure Applications

Karen McIntyre recommended a motion be made to accept the findings regarding applicant APP-000534961 from the FCCPT Credential Evaluation that the individual's education is substantially equivalent to the first professional degree in physical therapy in the United States, based on the documentation provided, for PT endorsement and deny the TOEFL waiver request due to the lack of statutory authority. CJ Miller moved, and Tony Ganim seconded. Karen McIntyre and Mario Baker abstained, All in favor. Motion carried

Karen McIntyre recommended a motion be made to accept the findings from the FCCPT Credential Evaluation regarding application APP-000605590's education is not substantially equivalent to the first professional degree in physical therapy in the United States, based on the documentation provided, for PTA examination. CJ Miller moved, and Tony Ganim seconded. Karen McIntyre and Mario Baker abstained, All in favor. Motion carried.

Karen McIntyre recommended a motion be made to accept the findings regarding applicant APP-000589200 from the FCCPT Credential Evaluation that the individual's education IS substantially equivalent to the first professional degree in physical therapy in the United States, based on the documentation provided, for PT endorsement and to proceed with licensure. CJ Miller moved, and Tony Ganim seconded. Karen McIntyre and Mario Baker abstained, All in favor. Motion carried.

Mario Baker moved that the Physical Therapy Section ratify, as submitted, the physical therapist and physical therapist assistant licenses issued by examination, endorsement and reinstatement by the Ohio Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Athletic Trainers Board from May 20, 2022 to July 21, 2022, taking into account those licenses subject to discipline, surrender, or non-renewal. New Business


