Continuing Education Requirement

Athletic Trainers

Review rule [4755-45-01](#) of the Athletic Training Laws and Rules for current continuing education requirements.

Important Information:

How to calculate your continuing education activity: One contact hour is one clock hour spent in a continuing education activity. Athletic Trainers are required to complete no fewer than 25 contact hours per renewal cycle.

Continuing education must include at least one contact hour of ethics education. Licensees can meet the ethics requirement by successfully passing the “Athletic Trainers Licensure Law Test” found at <http://otptat.ohio.gov/AthleticTraining/ATJurisprudenceExam.aspx>.

Please note: In a recent rule change, the AT Section elected to eliminate the in-person training and evidence-based practice requirements. The total number of hours remains 25, but the category is no longer counted separately.

Licensees are not required to obtain any continuing education units for the first renewal.

Continuing education must be completed within the two-year licensure period. For a license that expired on September 30, 2020, twenty-five hours of continuing education must have been completed between October 1, 2018 and September 30, 2020.
